

Changes to our services

In response to the COVID19 outbreak we have made some changes to the services we provide so that we can better respond to the needs of disabled people we work with.

Support for People who Employ PAs to provide social care support

PA register for people in need of short-term/emergency support

We are looking for PAs who may be available for work to support people in need of short-term support due to the COVID 19 outbreak to replace PAs who are unable to work at this time. PAs can register here using this on-line form, which includes contact details, skills and availability.

People looking for a PA (Individuals in receipt of a direct payment Care Managers, Social Workers, Support Providers) can download and complete a Referral for PA support form here and email it to CV19@disabilitysheffield.org.uk We will match people in need of a PA with PAs on our register.

The PA register is not able to support people who are looking to recruit PAs for the first time, for example, someone who usually attends day services who now requires support at home due to the closure of the day service. Key Worker status

We are able to provide a letter from Sheffield City Council confirming that a named PA is a key worker. This letter can be used for authorisation when out and about carrying out duties related to work as a PA, and when travelling to and from work.

Access to Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

We are currently liaising with Sheffield City Council on the supply of PPE. At present if you are requiring PPE please contact us with details and we will pass your request on to the council. In the near future we hope to have our own supply and be in a position to directly respond to requests.

Individual Employer and PA Frequently Asked Questions

We have produced an information sheet of FAQs including guidance from Sheffield City Council on the use of direct payments during this period. The information sheet will be regularly updated and can be download from our website.

On-line PA register

Our on-line PA register is still available for people wishing to recruit new PAs or for PAs looking for a job.

Disability-related Support, Information and Resources

There is a dedicated page on our website with information for disabled people related to Coronavirus including easy-read resources. This page is being regularly updated as guidance changes and we find new information.
